25 March 2020 Law Decree: the updated list of permitted activities

On 25 March 2020 the Minister of Economy and Finance has updated the list of activities that are excluded from the temporary lockdown of production, decided by the Italian government through the Prime Minister's Decree of 22 March (the "22 March Decree"). These activities are identified through their economic activity code (ATECO), which is the Italian equivalent of the EU NACE codes. The new list of permitted activities is attached as Annex 1.

The remaining provisions of the 22 March Decree, including those relating to the supply chain companies and role of the Prefecture (*prefettura*) in deciding on their possible closure, remain unchanged (<u>see newsletter</u>).
