Renewables Decree: the GSE publishes the calls for tender for the Ranking List and Rebate Auction procedures

As explained in our newsletter of 24 June 2016 on this topic (the **June Newsletter**), the Italian Ministry for the Economic Development (**MSE**) recently approved the decree (**Renewables Decree**) that provides for new incentives in favor of renewables other than photovoltaic.

(Any capitalized term used in this newsletter has the same meaning ascribed to it in the June Newsletter, which, for convenience, is available [here](#)).

As also described in the June Newsletter, based on the Renewables Decree, Wind Farms can access the Incentives through procedures which vary depending on the size of the Wind Farms: Wind Farms up to 60 kW will have the right to directly access the Incentives, whereas Wind Farms above 60 kW will have the right to receive the Incentives by participating in:

- a. a Ranking List procedure (Wind Farms with nominal capacity between 60kW and 5000kW); or
- b. a Rebate Auction procedure (Wind Farms with nominal capacity above 5000 kW).

Pursuant to the Renewables Decree, on 20 August 2016, the GSE published the **calls for tenders** for the **Ranking List** and the **Rebate Auction**.

The Registers, for the enrolment with the GSE Ranking List, will open on **30 August 2016 (9:00 am)** and will close on **28 October 2016 (9:00 pm)**.

The Rebate Auction procedures will open on **30 August 2016 (9:00 am)** and will close on **27 November 2016 (9:00 pm)**.

The applications can only be submitted electronically, within the deadline above, using the computer application **FER-E** made available by the GSE ([here](#)) 24 hours a day.
